Farrowing Crates: Animal Squad Call to Action

A farrowing crate is a metal barred cage that a mother pig is locked in for up to five weeks, when she has her babies. It is so small that she can only stand up or lie down. She cannot turn around or build a nest for her piglets. There is no straw for bedding, only hard, cold ground. This is no way to treat a mother.

Parliament is currently deciding if they want New Zealand to stop using farrowing crates. Members of Parliament (or MPs) are elected to represent Kiwis; as kind Kiwis we need to ask them to stand up for animals.

This is your chance to tell Jacinda Ardern that farrowing crates need to be banned. We have a very caring Prime Minister. As a mother herself, she will listen to kids who care about pigs and want this bad way of treating them to end. Kids like you.

How to help: Just do a piece of writing, poem or picture about why farrowing crates are cruel or how pigs feel when they are locked up in these crates.
